Woodturning

Roger Cheshire and his wife Irene came along with a grand display of Roger's wood turning. Roger told us about the art of woodturning, prior to machinery, dates back thousands of years. Using a round block of wood and string. Two men pulled the string back and forth, stretcher poles and chair legs were their main concern. Many years later it was developed into a one- man job by throwing a rope round a tree, man soon started to make bowls, plates and even spoons. Nothing was wasted, even the shavings went on to fires. Sadly, the art soon died out as over the years all that could be made was spindles for stair cases.

Thankfully it came back as a hobby for the average man, probably working from his garden shed or garage. Using a small lathe (12000 revs) Roger demonstrated how a square chair leg could be turned into a round chair leg, he also put grooves to make patterns in the leg. Roger told us how different countries had different chair leg shapes. It is hard to believe or understand how years ago all this was done by hand. Years ago a piece of leather would be used to 'burn 'either side of the pattern, today, Roger uses a piano wire.

Roger's favourite wood is 'Yew'. He stresses how important your health is, so he always uses a full head mask to prevent him inhaling the dust and has an extractor fan fitted in his garage.
